
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the CAP Sewer Authority Mid Coastside Resilience Project – Section 205 in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The funding would be used for a Continuing Authorities Program Section 205 feasibility study of flood protection measures for a wastewater treatment plan in Half Moon Bay, California. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide flood protection for a facility that serves 27,000 of my constituents and has been at risk of failure during recent storms.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948, as amended (Public Law 118-272).
