Dear Chairman Simpson and Ranking Member Pingree,

I write to request \$320,000 in community project funding for the City of Campbell for treating stormwater runoff from approximately 2.5 acres of the Campbell Community Center parking lot and convey it to a subsurface infiltration system located beneath a portion of the play field, where it will recharge the local groundwater. The improvements will reduce nonpoint-source pollution and enhance groundwater replenishment in alignment with watershed-based management goals.
