Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the City of Campbell for Stormwater Runoff Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Campbell, located at 70 North First Street, Campbell, California 95008. The funding would be used to treat stormwater runoff from approximately 2.5 acres of the Campbell Community Center parking lot and convey it to a subsurface infiltration system located beneath a portion of the play field, where it will recharge the local groundwater. B. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because reducing pollutant-laden runoff entering Los Gatos Creek—an important recreational and ecological resource—and by capturing and infiltrating excess winter stormwater to support long-term groundwater replenishment.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
