I am requesting funding for the Mid Coasts Water Treatment Plant, CA in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, located at Attn. PAO USACE SPN, 450 Golden Gate Ave., 4th Floor, San Francisco, California 94102. The funding would be used for a Continuing Authorities Program Section 205 feasibility study of flood protection measures for a wastewater treatment plan in Half Moon Bay, California. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide flood protection for a facility that serves 27,000 of my constituents and has been at risk of failure during recent storms.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948, as amended (Public Law 118-272).
