
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the City of Pacifica for Stormwater Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Pacifica, located at 170 Santa Maria Avenue, Pacifica, California 94044. The funding would be used for major stormwater improvements, including a new permanent pump station at Clarendon Road and Lakeside Avenue, approximately 900 feet of 36-inch force main and improved outfall, and replacement of 700 feet of undersized storm drain near Brighton Road with a new 24-inch pipe. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will reduce chronic flooding, protect public infrastructure and private property and improve public safety.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
