
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical System Relocation Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside, located at 1000 Cabrillo Highway N, Half Moon Bay, California 94019. The funding would be used for relocating the plant's electrical equipment to higher ground to prevent their failure during storm-induced flooding. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will protect the coastal environment, public health, local economy, and community by reducing the risk of failure that could lead to sanitary sewer overflows into the community and the nearby Pacific Ocean.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 (16 U.S.C. § 1451 et seq.).
