I am requesting funding for the San Mateo Resource Conservation District for Water System Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Mateo Resource Conservation District, located at 80 Stone Pine Road, Half Moon Bay California, 94019. The funding would be used for targeted improvements to replace failing mid-century infrastructure. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve water supply reliability and increase water storage capacity by more than one day of emergency water storage for 19,000 residents.
