
Dear Chairman Simpson and Ranking Member Pingree,

I write to request \$1,256,000 in community project funding for the San Mateo Resource Conservation District. The project will support critical infrastructure upgrades that will restore reliable, safe water service for three small rural communities in the south coast region of San Mateo County, California. Specifically, the project will construct targeted improvements to replace failing mid century infrastructure and deliver measurable, high-impact benefits. Implementation includes installing over three miles of new, resilient pipeline, constructing more than 100,000 gallons of new domestic and emergency water storage, and modernizing pumps, treatment components, and distribution equipment. These upgrades will reduce system failures, prevent catastrophic leaks that currently render systems unusable for extended periods, and ensure that households have dependable water during droughts, storms, and power shutoffs.
